A. CONSENT FORM-HEAD LICE INSPECTIONS

Throughout your child/children's school years, the school will be arranging head lice inspections when necessary.

The management of head lice infection works best when all children are involved in our screening program.

The school is aware that this can be a sensitive issue and is committed to maintaining student confidentiality and avoiding stigmatisation.

Before any inspections are conducted staff will explain to all students what is being done and why, and it will be emphasised to students that the presence of head lice in their hair does not mean that their hair is less clean or well-kept than anyone else's. It will also be pointed out that head lice can be itchy and annoying and if you know you have got them, you can do something about it.

The inspection of students will be conducted by, e.g. local council appointed nurse, parent volunteers trained by the local council, school nurse or health officer.

The person conducting the inspections will check through each student's hair to see if any lice or eggs are present.

In cases where head lice are found, the person inspecting the student will inform the principal. The school will make appropriate contact with the parents/guardians.

Please note that the law requires that where a child has head lice, that child should not return to school until appropriate treatment has commenced.

NOTE PLEASE : IMMUNISATION & BIRTH CERTIFICATES

Immunisation Certificate:

When enrolling a child in primary school, parents must provide the child's Immunisation Status Certificate. This shows whether a child has been immunised against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, whooping cough and haemophilus influenza type B.

The Child History Statement from the **Australian Childhood Immunisation Register** (<http://www.humanservices.gov.au/customer/services/medicare/australian-childhood-immunisation-register>) may be used, but is only valid if it contains the statement 'this child has received all vaccines required by 5 years of age'.

Children who are not immunised can still attend school. If an outbreak of an infectious disease occurs at the school they will be sent home until the danger has passed.

Birth Certificate:

A copy of the student's Birth Certificate is a legal requirement when enrolling a student at a Victorian School. A copy of the certificate is kept on file at school.

The student must be enrolled by the exact name on their birth certificate unless there are any other legal documents in place.
